Ira C. Kelley Award: The purpose of this Award is to further encourage and promote advancements and achievements in the environmental laboratory field. The Award may be presented annually to a member of the Association who has demonstrated outstanding accomplishments in operating an environmental laboratory facility; performed outstanding service in instruction and training other laboratory analysts; contributed to advancement of the laboratory field; and/or developed analytical techniques, procedures, or instrumentation. **(Receive 4 additional points on an inspection by submitting a nomination for this award)**

WEF Laboratory Analyst Excellence Award: This award was established to recognize individuals for outstanding performance, professionalism, and contributions to the water quality analysis profession. The candidate must be a member of the Water Environment Federation, employed at an educational facility laboratory, industrial, commercial, or municipal laboratory which performs wastewater-related analyses, and must have direct analytical responsibilities. Criteria include membership and involvement in professional associations, outstanding efforts in the area of wastewater and environmental analyses, involvement in community activities or public relations, presentations at professional conferences and meetings, professional certifications, continuing education, etc. **(Receive 4 additional points on an inspection by submitting a nomination for this award)**
